Guyana

- Georgetown, the capital city, is also Guyana's largest city at 213,000 inhabitants (2002 Census).
- 43% of the population lives below the poverty level.¹
- Guyana is religiously diverse: about 50% are Christian, 28% are Hindu, and 7% are Muslim.²
- The legal age of sexual consent is 16.³
- Abortion became legal in Guyana in 1995.⁴

After Choosing Life, Life Was Hard—for a Time

Josie came for a free pregnancy test. Having another baby at this time of her life would be a disaster, she said. The counselor talked with her about alternatives to abortion and God's love for the preborn. Josie's heart changed; if she were pregnant, she would give life to her child.

The test was positive. Josie told the baby's father she was pregnant—he packed his bags and left. But, with the support of her parents and promised assistance from EPAS, Josie had hope.

On her due date, Josie was admitted to the hospital for a C-Section, but before they started the surgery, a doctor noticed Josie's blood pressure was way above normal level. He immediately transported her to the theatre where she could be monitored. Much later, she awoke to doctors' voices and questioning looks. They asked, "How did you make it? Women with your experience of high blood pressure who go into cardiac arrest don't usually make it."

Josie gave birth to a bouncing boy, but that's not all. His father reunited with Josie after learning of their son—they're planning to marry. When their son was four months old, Josie got the first job of her life!
